DUO BIO

Founded 2016 in New York City, *Diálogos Duo* is the preeminent U.S. clarinet-guitar duo specializing in contemporary Brazilian music. "*Diálogos*" means "*Dialogues*" in Portuguese.

Boukas's one hundred compositions for the Duo are the largest body of contemporary Brazilian repertoire for clarinet and guitar worldwide. Fusing traditional and popular Brazilian genres with contemporary jazz and classical vocabularies, each piece is a tribute to a legendary Brazilian musician. The Duo's two recordings are: *Choro Tributes* and *Homages to Brazilian Masters*.

Performances include *ClarinetFest* (International Clarinet Association, 2021, 2019), *Jazz Forum* (Tarrytown, NY), *NYC Classical Guitar Society*, *Sacred Heart University "Art of the Duo"* (CT), *Performance Today (American Public Media)* and *WKCR-FM Jobim Marathon (Columbia Univ.)*.

LOUIS ARQUES is a clarinet virtuoso from Grenoble, France. A *Vandoren* artist, he has taught at *Paris Conservatoire*, *Ithaca College (NY)* and *Diller-Quaile School of Music (NYC)*. An itinerant chamber and orchestral soloist (*String Orchestra of Brooklyn, Mannes Orch.*), jazz and Afro-Cuban music, he is founder and artistic director of *Avalanche Orchestra*.

RICHARD BOUKAS is an internationally acclaimed guitarist, vocalist, composer, educator and scholar of Brazilian music. LaBella Strings artist and faculty at New School for the Performing Arts (NYC), he has been guest artist-educator at New York Guitar Seminar (Mannes), Harvard Univ., Denver Univ., Cincinnati Conservatory, Hudson Jazz Workshop; in Brazil: Campos do Jordão (São Paulo), UFMG/Belo Horizonte and UniRio/Rio de Janeiro.
